What I have done

- Launched a housing Survey to Understand the problems students face with housing.

- Increased International student engagement with the re-introduction of International Café
- Brought back player of the match meal for sports teams and got drinks reduced on Wednesdays.
- Reviewed Bye Laws of the Societies and Sports Executive committee for more clarity and Improved funding procedure.
- Introduced my own campus radio show (Campus Vibes) to keep students updated with services and events on campus.
- Improved engagements with BME community through events during black History Month that engaged over 400 students.

What I will do

- Improve the level of student engagement with our SU through Societies and sports Clubs.
- Put pressure University to get It's health centre reviewed by the Care Quality Commission.
- Work with the University Services to provide more support and awareness on mental health.
- Work with the University's security and local police to for increased visibility and push the petition to light up Wallness Lane.
- Work with Uni authorities to put an end to the unnecessary parking ticket issuance and Lobby the University for reduced parking charges and more parking space for students.
- Continue my work for a Housing Accreditation Scheme that is run by your SU.
- Work with the officer team and Schools to improve assessment feedback times and push for even more practical learning approach to boost your employability.
- Work closely with the careers team for improved careers advice and more placements.
- Provide more support for International and Erasmus Students in the wake of BREXIT.
- Free printing in your Students Union.
- Start a campaign for reduced food prices at the Student Store.
