CAMPAIGNS

Liberation

From hate crimes & racist policy like Prevent, to the under-representation of women in academia - we need to ensure the success of all minorities.

If elected, I'll put liberation firmly on the agenda so that all students are able to live and work on our campus equally, regardless of race, gender, religion, sexuality or disability.

Mental Health

Poor mental health affects 1 in 4 students and yet the waiting list for help is several months long.

If elected I will demand more investment into this vital service, and a reboot of the tutor system to ensure early referrals.

Hidden Course Costs

We're paying £9k a year but still have to fork out for printing and course material. If elected I will ensure that the university comes clean on hidden course fees so you know exactly what you will need for your course, and I will lobby the university to invest tuition fees into subsidising these costs.

Safety

Campaigns like **Light Up Salford** have made it clear that we do not feel safe on our campus, and the university should do more to ensure that as students we are better protected on our campus and in the local area,

If elected I will lobby the university alongside the local council to improve our safety with better lighting and CCTV cameras.

Sports

Clubs are forced to pay for spaces off campus and timetable clashes mean not everyone can participate. If elected, I will demand investment into sports facilities on campus and Wednesday evening off for all courses.

Accommodation

University management have privatised our accommodation, and CLV have little to show for it besides higher costs, poorer maintenance and non-existent customer service.

If elected, I will ensure that the union and university hold CLV to account, demanding improved services and better value for money.

International Students/Migrants

The university and union must be doing more to support international students during their time here.

If elected I will work on a Freeze the Fees campaign to cap the increases on tuition fees for international students, and work with the ISC to amplify their voices.
